

THE OLYMPIC EXHIBITION, SPORT AND URBAN CULTURES



Paris je t'aime – Tourist Office and the Olympic Museum in Lausanne present 'SPOT24 – the Olympic Exhibition', which has been awarded the Cultural Olympiad label. For groups or individuals.

SPOT24 reveals the history and richness of the 'young' Olympic disciplines, at the crossroads of urban cultures and artistic expression: **3x3 basketball, BMX freestyle, climbing, skateboarding, surfing and breaking**. The Olympic history of these six sports is the common thread running through the exhibition, in dialogue with art and street cultures. The SPOT24 exhibition features objects from the collection of the Olympic Museum in Lausanne, original creations by renowned artists, archives and works from private collections.

SPOT24 includes a tourist information and ticketing centre, an **official shop** selling Paris je t'aime and Paris 2024 products, and the **SPOT24 Café**.

GREATER PARIS BOASTS HUNDREDS OF MUSEUMS, MONUMENTS AND CHATEAUX ... A CULTURAL OFFERING LIKE NO OTHER! WITH PARIS JE T'AIME, YOU CAN VISIT ALL THE MUST-SEE ATTRACTIONS AS WELL AS UNUSUAL TREASURES.

The Louvre Museum, the Château de Versailles, the Château de Vaux-le-Vicomte, the Arc de Triomphe and the Eiffel Tower are all emblematic of Paris as a destination ... But the capital has much more to offer!

History buffs won't want to miss the Conciergerie and its neighbour the Sainte-Chapelle, on the Île de la Cité, or the basilica-cathedral of Saint-Denis, where the kings and queens of France are buried; the Musée de l'Armée, at Les Invalides; or the marvellous Hôtel de la Marine, on Place de la Concorde.

Fans of the fine arts can visit the Musée d'Orsay, home to the masters of Impressionism, the Musée de l'Orangerie, and the Musée Rodin Paris, located in the former home of the famous sculptor and surrounded by a charming garden. Paris also has a wealth of modern and contemporary art on offer: the Centre Pompidou, the national museum of modern art,

as well as the not-to-be-missed Fondation Louis Vuitton – accessible with a premium ticket, which is not dated – and the Bourse de Commerce – Pinault Collection.

Sites to discover with the whole family include the Musée du quai Branly – Jacques Chirac, devoted to the arts of Africa, Asia, the Americas and Oceania; the Cité des Sciences et de l'Industrie, in the vast Parc de la Villette; and the Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle, in the heart of the Jardin des Plantes. As for the Tour Montparnasse, it offers a unique panoramic view of the capital.

GOOD TO KNOW At the Musée du Louvre and the Château de Versailles, Paris je t'aime helps you book both self-guided and group visits.



→ **Pass Navigo Easy, pre-loaded with 10 t+ tickets:** ideal for occasional travel in Paris. Valid on the bus network, metro, tramway, RER and Montmartre funicular.

→ **'Carnet' of 10 t+ tickets, youth group rate:** for groups of 10 secondary school pupils travelling as part of a school trip, accompanied by a teacher.

→ **Paris Visite*:** the nominative pass for unlimited travel in Greater Paris, in adult or child version, for 1, 2, 3 or 5 consecutive days, zones 1 to 3 or zones 1 to 5.

*For the 2024 Games: the **Paris 2024 Pass** (valid from 20 July to 8 September 2024) gives you unlimited travel for the duration of your choice (1 to 7 days) and enables you to get to the competition venues in Greater Paris.

→ **Access to the Château de Versailles:** valid for one journey between Paris and Versailles – Château station (RER C); available in adult or child versions.

→ **Access to Disneyland® Paris:** valid for a journey between Paris and Marne-la-Vallée – Chessy station (RER A); available in adult or child versions.

→ **Airport transfer Paris – Charles de Gaulle:** RoissyBus shuttle or metro + RER B ticket.

→ **Paris – Orly airport transfer:** OrlyBus shuttle or metro + RER B + OrlyVal ticket.



SIGHTSEEING CRUISES ON THE SEINE

→ LUNCHES AND DINNER CRUISES

Passengers enjoy **top-quality cuisine prepared by renowned chefs**, while admiring the most beautiful monuments in Paris. The cosy ambience and attentive service create a romantic atmosphere. → CRUISES ON THE CANAL ST-MARTIN

A **unique and charming experience**: 4.5 km long, this canal has nine locks and two swing bridges. Cruise under the romantic arches of the Bastille, admire the colourful facades of the Quai de Valmy and take in the legendary Hôtel du Nord.

→ BATOBUS CRUISE

The Batobus ticket gives you unlimited access, for 24 or 48 consecutive hours, to the shuttle service on the Seine: a made-to-measure cruise, with the possibility of getting on and off as you please at the nine stops along the way, from the Jardin des Plantes to the Eiffel Tower.

➔ **MOULIN ROUGE**

It's one of the most famous cabarets in the world ... Since its creation in 1889, the evenings at Moulin Rouge have come alive to the rhythm of the famous French cancan. Feathers, rhinestones and sequins are the order of the day: every night, the Moulin Rouge and its 80 artists present **the 'Féerie' revue**. A two-hour show featuring dance tableaux, surprise acts, exceptional performances and sumptuous sets.

➔ **PARADIS LATIN**




→ **LE BISTRO PARISIEN**

→ WHAT PAYMENT METHODS ARE AVAILABLE?

We offer 3 methods of payment:

→ **By credit card;**

→ **By cheque:** made payable to the Paris Convention and Visitors Bureau and sent to the following address: Paris je t'aime – Tourist Office, Ticketing Department, 76 rue Beaubourg – 75003 Paris – France;

→ **By bank transfer:** our bank details are shown on the quotation you will receive. As soon as we receive your payment, we will inform you and send your order.

→ IS IT POSSIBLE TO PAY BY POSTAL ORDER?

We accept payment by postal order, within one month of receipt of the invoice and dispatch of the products. To do this, you will need to send us your order form duly completed (SIRET / service code / commitment number) and signed.

→ HOW LONG IS MY QUOTE VALID FOR?

For a service that is not dated, the quote will remain valid for one month from the date it is sent. If you do not confirm your booking within this period, the quote will be automatically cancelled and you will have to make a new request.

For a dated service, the period of validity of your quote depends on the service booked. It can vary from 2 hours to 10 days on average, from the date of dispatch.

→ WHAT ARE THE CONDITIONS FOR CANCELLING AND MODIFYING BOOKINGS?

You will be informed of the conditions governing changes and/or cancellations when you book your activities. These conditions vary according to the activity booked.

→ HOW LONG ARE TICKETS VALID FOR?

Tickets are valid either for a specific date or until a certain date. You will be given this information when you place your order.
