The history of this great palace is marked by eight centuries of French monarchs, from the Capetians to the Bonapartes. The entrance ticket gives access to the Grands Appartements and the Musée Napoléon I.

Bordered on one side by the town and on the other by woods, the Château de Vincennes is a beautifully restored jewel of medieval architecture.

CITÉ DES SCIENCES ET DE L'INDUSTRIE

The Cité was set up in 1986 to give the general public a better understanding of all the different branches of science. HÔTEL DES INVALIDES – MUSÉE DE L'ARMÉE

King Louis XIV ordered the building of the Hôtel National des Invalides in 1670. Inside the Musée de l'Armée is one of the world's largest military museums, with a collection of some 500,000 objects. Napoleon Bonaparte's body was entombed in the Église du Dôme chapel.

ARC DE TRIOMPHE

Built to commemorate Napoleon's victory at the Battle of Austerlitz, this is the world's largest triumphal arch. The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier was placed beneath it in 1921, and a memorial flame is rekindled there every evening. There is a breathtaking view of Paris from the observation deck at the top.

CHÂTEAU DE VERSAILLES

CHÂTEAU DE VINCENNES
