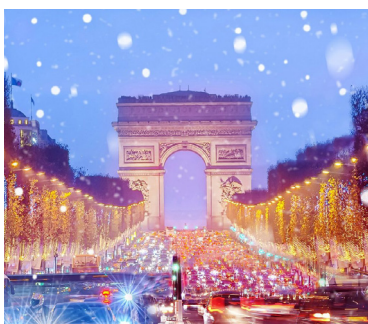

Paris Passlib' is the official city pass for the destination Paris. It gives admission to many cultural sites (museums, monuments, chateaux, etc.) and sightseeing activities (open-top buses, Seine cruises etc.) and entitles the holder to free use of public transport. Access to the Eiffel Tower can be purchased as an option.

THE LOUVRE

MUSÉE DE L'ORANGERIE

This museum houses one of art history's biggest works: eight panels of the monumental compositions Claude Monet painted as part of his celebrated Water Lilies series. The Jean Walter and Paul Guillaume collection in the basement pays homage to great 20th-century artists such as Renoir, Cézanne, Matisse, Picasso and Soutine.

CITÉ DES SCIENCES ET DE L'INDUSTRIE

The Cité was set up in 1986 to give the general public a better understanding of all the different branches of science. The main building, Explora, spreads over five floors hosting the permanent collections, a planetarium, two cinemas and a children's museum. Outside, you will find the Argonaute (a real 1950s French Navy submarine) and the Géode cinema.

MUSÉUM NATIONAL D'HISTOIRE NATURELLE

Paris's natural history museum is a huge place, so set aside at least half a day to visit it. With dinosaur skeletons, meteorites, live animals and naturalized specimens, the museum and its magnificent botanical garden (Jardin des Plantes) are worth examining at leisure.

MUSÉE YVES SAINT LAURENT – PARIS

This museum devoted to one of the 20th century's most iconic fashion designers has a unique collection of couture dresses, accessories, sketches, photos and videos, displayed in the Second Empire mansion where Yves Saint Laurent's teams worked for 30 years.

HÔTEL DES INVALIDES – MUSÉE DE L'ARMÉE

King Louis XIV ordered the building of the Hôtel National des Invalides in 1670. The Musée de l'Armée inside is one of the world's largest military museums, with a collection of some 500,000 objects. Napoleon Bonaparte's body was entombed in the Église du Dôme chapel.

A guided tour offers a journey into France's military history and explores the collections of weapons and armour used in medieval, royal and Renaissance France and the Napoleonic era.

ARC DE TRIOMPHE

Built to commemorate Napoleon's victory at the Battle of Austerlitz, this is the world's largest triumphal arch. The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier was placed beneath it in 1921, and a memorial flame is rekindled there every evening. There is a breathtaking view of Paris from the observation deck at the top.

CHÂTEAU DE VERSAILLES

CHÂTEAU DE FONTAINEBLEAU

DOMAINE DE CHANTILLY

LA SEINE MUSICALE

Designed by the architects Shigeru Ban and Jean de Gastines, this stunning music complex at the tip of the Île Seguin island in Boulogne-Billancourt resembles an ocean liner anchored in the Seine. Hosting big-name French and international performers, it has attracted music lovers in their droves since it opened in 2017.

PALAIS GARNIER – OPÉRA NATIONAL DE PARIS

This gem of Second Empire architecture – all gold, marble and mirrors – is open for visits in the daytime and hosts concerts and ballets in the evening. It is an iconic example of Haussmann’s renovation of Paris. The stunning opera house has long been a source of inspiration for writers, artists and filmmakers.

TOUR MONTPARNASSE PANORAMIC OBSERVATORY

At 210 metres, the 56-storey Tour Montparnasse is the tallest building within Paris proper. It offers the most stunning view of the city from its rooftop terrace. The tower is beautifully lit up every night using a dynamic LED system that adjusts brightness and changes colour with the seasons.

The 56th floor of the tower offers breathtaking views of Paris and its monuments from behind plate glass windows. A few stairs lead up to the outdoor rooftop observatory and another panoramic view.

CONCIERGERIE

This Gothic edifice has played a significant role in French history. The first royal residence of the Kings of France, it was a fearsome prison during the French Revolution. Saint Louis, King Philippe IV Le Bel, Robespierre and Marie-Antoinette are among the famous names associated with the monument.

The highlights of a visit include the Salle des Gens d'armes (Hall of the Men in Arms) dating to 1302, a few of the prison cells and the expiatory chapel – the room Marie-Antoinette inhabited until her execution.

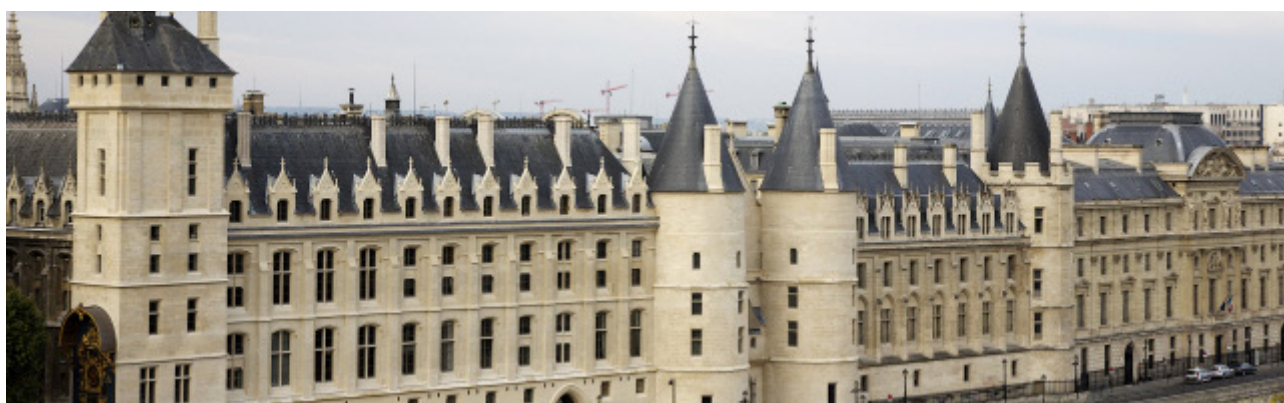

SAINTE-CHAPELLE

Built in the mid-13th century by Saint Louis (King Louis IX) inside the Palais de la Cité, this gem of Flamboyant Gothic French architecture has preserved all its original splendour, as evidenced by the magnificent stained-glass windows in the upper chapel and the golden fleur-de-lys on the vaulted ceiling of the lower chapel.

Originally built to house the relics of the Passion of Christ (dispersed following the Revolution), Sainte-Chapelle has come down through the ages with its majesty intact.

SAINT-DENIS BASILICA CATHEDRAL

The basilica was completed in the 13th century, but its history dates to the 5th century, when a shrine was built here over the tomb of St. Denis. A powerful royal abbey in the Middle Ages, this Gothic art masterpiece contains the tombs of 43 kings and 32 queens of France.
