



#### **MUSÉE D'ORSAY**

The Musée d'Orsay is an exceptional setting for hundreds of masterpieces covering the full spectrum of Western art (painting, sculpture, the decorative arts, photography, etc.) from 1848 to 1914. Works by the leading Impressionist painters are displayed here.

#### MUSÉE DU QUAI BRANLY – JACQUES CHIRAC

#### **GRÉVIN PARIS**

#### CITÉ DES SCIENCES ET DE L'INDUSTRIE

The Cité was set up in 1986 to give the general public a better understanding of all the different branches of science. The main building, Explora, spreads over five floors hosting the permanent collections, a planetarium, two cinemas and a children's museum. Outside, you will find the Argonaute (a real 1950s French Navy submarine) and the Géode cinema.

#### MUSÉUM NATIONAL D'HISTOIRE NATURELLE

Paris's natural history museum is a huge place, so set aside at least half a day to visit it. With dinosaur skeletons, meteorites, live animals and naturalized specimens, the museum and its magnificent botanical garden (Jardin des Plantes) are worth examining at leisure.

#### HÔTEL DES INVALIDES – MUSÉE DE L'ARMÉE

King Louis XIV ordered the building of the Hôtel National des Invalides in 1670. Inside the Musée de l'Armée is one of the world's largest military museums, with a collection of some 500,000 objects. Napoleon Bonaparte's body was entombed in the Église du Dôme chapel.

#### ARC DE TRIOMPHE

Built to commemorate Napoleon's victory at the Battle of Austerlitz, this is the world's largest triumphal arch. The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier was placed beneath it in 1921, and a memorial flame is rekindled there every evening. There is a breathtaking view of Paris from the observation deck at the top.

#### CHÂTEAU DE FONTAINEBLEAU

The history of this great palace, like its architecture, is marked by eight centuries of French monarchs, from the Capetians to the Bonapartes. Masterpieces include the horseshoe staircase, the bed of Marie Antoinette and the throne of Napoleon.

#### **CHÂTEAU DE RAMBOUILLET**

Built in the heart of a vast forest full of game some fifty kilometres from Paris, this former medieval fortress has undergone numerous transformations over the centuries. From 1896, and up until 2009, the estate was a holiday residence of the presidents of the French Republic.

#### CHÂTEAU DE VINCENNES

Bordered on one side by the town and on the other by woods, the Château de Vincennes is a beautifully restored jewel of medieval archi-tecture. Among the highlights of a visit: the keep - 50 metres high -, the Sainte-Chapelle, the fortifications, and the Tour du Village, which provides access to the site.

#### DOMAINE DE CHANTILLY

The Chantilly estate has many treasures: the castle (home to one of the finest collections of paintings in France after the Louvre); the beautiful 115-hectare park and the 18th-century Grandes Écuries (Great Stables) housing the Musée du Cheval (Horse Museum), where equestrian shows are held.

#### CINÉMATHÈQUE FRANÇAISE

Situated at the Parc de Bercy, the Cinémathèque française celebrates cinema. Housed in an iconic curved building by American architect Frank O. Gehry, it comprises a museum, projection rooms, a documentation centre, and programmes many temporary exhibitions and cultural activities.

#### MUSÉE MÉLIÈS, THE MAGIC OF CINEMA

A fun 800 m² exhibition to discover the history of cinema through the work of Georges Méliès. On the programme: a collection of over 300 machines, costumes, drawings, models, 150 period photographs and many other surprises. **Undated ticket valid for 1 year from the date of purchase.**

#### OBSERVATOIRE PANORAMIQUE DE LA TOUR MONTPARNASSE

At 210 metres, the 56-storey Tour Montparnasse is the tallest building within Paris proper. It offers the most stunning view of the city from its rooftop terrace. The tower is beautifully lit up every night using a dynamic LED system that adjusts brightness and changes colour with the seasons.

The 56th floor of the tower offers breathtaking views of Paris and its monuments from behind plate glass windows. A few stairs lead up to the outdoor rooftop observatory and another panoramic view.

#### **MONNAIE DE PARIS**

Founded in 864 and housed in the Palais Conti since the 18th century, the Monnaie de Paris is the oldest French institution and the oldest company in the world. After several years of renovation work, the site opens its doors to the public for the first time and inaugurates its museum project the 11 quai Conti – unveiling 12 centuries of heritage and collections devoted to coinage.

#### CONCIERGERIE

This Gothic edifice has played a significant role in French history. The first royal residence of the Kings of France was a formidable prison during the French Revolution. Saint Louis, King Philippe IV Le Bel, Robespierre and Marie-Antoinette are among the famous names associated with the monument.

The highlights of a visit include the Salle des Gens d'armes (Hall of the Men in Arms) dating to 1302, a few of the prison cells and the expiatory chapel the room Marie-Antoinette inhabited until her execution.

#### SAINTE-CHAPELLE

Built in the mid-13th century by Saint Louis (King Louis IX) inside the Palais de la Cité, this gem of Flamboyant Gothic French architecture has preserved all its original splendour, as evidenced by the magnificent stained-glass windows in the upper chapel and the golden fleur-de-lys on the vaulted ceiling of the lower chapel.

Originally built to house the relics of the Passion of Christ (dispersed following the Revolution), Sainte-Chapelle has come down through the ages with its majesty intact.



#### SAINT-DENIS BASILICA CATHEDRAL

The basilica was completed in the 13th century, but its history dates to the 5th century, when a shrine was built here over the tomb of St. Denis. A powerful royal abbey in the Middle Ages, this Gothic art masterpiece contains the tombs of 43 kings and 32 queens of France.

#### CITÉ DE L'ARCHITECTURE & DU PATRIMOINE

Housed in the Palais de Chaillot, on Place du Trocadéro, the museum retraces 1,000 years of architectural and monumental heritage, from the Middle Ages to the present day. Highlights include a reproduction of the portal of Chartres Cathedral and a reproduction of an apartment of Le Corbusier's Cité Radieuse. Models, videos, and drawings make the visit even more interesting. Temporary exhibitions are also programmed to offer an expert insight into the urban planning of the past, present and future.

#### **PANTHEON**

This monument with its distinctive façade and dome stands atop the Montagne Sainte-Geneviève, a historic hill in the Latin Quarter. Formerly a church, it has served since the French Revolution as the final resting place of illustrious French citizens such as Victor Hugo, Jean Moulin and Marie Curie.

#### MUSÉE RODIN - PARIS

The Hôtel Biron, a gem of a private 18th-century mansion, houses the masterpieces of the sculptor Rodin and his companion and artist Camille Claudel. Visitors can discover other major works by the master as they stroll around the huge garden, including the famous *The Thinker*.

#### **MUSÉE PICASSO - PARIS**

#### ARCHAEOLOGICAL CRYPT OF THE ÎLE DE LA CITÉ

Tucked away under the paved forecourt of the cathedral of Notre-Dame, the largest crypt in Europe is a key witness to the history of Paris.
