## MUSÉE DU LOUVRE

Paris's biggest museum offers an overview of Western art (from the Middle Ages to 1848), art from ancient civilizations (Eastern, Egyptian, Greek, Etruscan, Roman), graphic arts and Islamic art. Significant works: *the Mona Lisa*, *the Raft of the Medusa*, *the Venus de Milo*, *the Winged Victory of Samothrace*, etc.

## HÔTEL DES INVALIDES – MUSÉE DE L'ARMÉE

King Louis XIV ordered the building of the Hôtel National des Invalides in 1670. Inside the Musée de l'Armée is one of the world's largest military museums, with a collection of some 500,000 objects. Napoleon Bonaparte's body was entombed in the Église du Dôme chapel.

## ARC DE TRIOMPHE

Built to commemorate Napoleon's victory at the Battle of Austerlitz, this is the world's largest triumphal arch. The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier was placed beneath it in 1921, and a memorial flame is rekindled there every evening. There is a breathtaking view of Paris from the observation deck at the top.

## CHÂTEAU DE VERSAILLES

## BOURSE DE COMMERCE – PINAULT COLLECTION

Restored and transformed by Japanese architect Tadao Ando, the historic building is a new temple for contemporary art in Paris, showcasing spectacular works and other works from the private collection of François Pinault.

## OBSERVATOIRE PANORAMIQUE DE LA TOUR MONTPARNASSE

At 210 metres, the 56-storey Tour Montparnasse is the tallest building within Paris proper. It offers the most stunning view of the city from its rooftop terrace. The tower is beautifully lit up every night using a dynamic LED system that adjusts brightness and changes colour with the seasons.

### SELF-GUIDED OBSERVATORY TOUR

The 56th floor of the tower offers breathtaking views of Paris and its monuments from behind plate glass windows. A few stairs lead up to the outdoor rooftop observatory and another panoramic view.



## CONCIERGERIE

This Gothic edifice has played a significant role in French history. The first royal residence of the Kings of France was a formidable prison during the French Revolution. 

## SAINTE-CHAPELLE

Built in the mid-13th century by Saint Louis (King Louis IX) inside the Palais de la Cité, this gem of Flamboyant Gothic French architecture has preserved all its original splendour, as evidenced by the magnificent stained-glass windows in the upper chapel and the golden fleur-de-lys on the vaulted ceiling of the lower chapel.

## CITÉ DE L'ARCHITECTURE & DU PATRIMOINE

Housed in the Palais de Chaillot, on Place du Trocadéro, the museum retraces 1,000 years of architectural and monumental heritage, from the Middle Ages to the present day. Highlights include a reproduction of the portal of Chartres Cathedral and a reproduction of an apartment of Le Corbusier's Cité Radieuse. Models, videos, and drawings make the visit even more interesting. Temporary exhibitions are also programmed to offer an expert insight into the urban planning of the past, present and future.

## STADE DE FRANCE

## THE REPUBLICAN GUARD

Heir to the Guard of Paris and a subdivision of the National Gendarmerie, the Republican Guard is made up of 2,800, both military and civilian, men and women. Its roles include ensuring public safety, and it also contributes to the cultural influence of France through its musical formations and special formations.

## PANTHEON





## WHAT METHODS OF PAYMENT ARE AVAILABLE?

## HOW LONG IS MY QUOTE VALID FOR?
